RCS YOUTH IN TRADES APPLICATION FORM

Youth Work in Trades (YIT) is a course offered by the Industry Training Program (ITA) for students who are interested in exploring the industry work force while in high school. Through YIT students are able to get on the job training as a youth apprentice under industry professionals.

Is this program for you?

- You're a student in grades 11 or 12
- You're 16 years of age or older
- You want on the job training in your trade of interest

Program Path



In B.C. there are currently more than 100 apprentice trade programs offering career opportunities. What these occupations have in common is that they require specialized skills, and involve working with your hands as well as your head, and the training is largely done on-the-job. Requirements for this Course

Students must be 16 years of age or older, attending high school and find a position in an apprenticeable trade. To qualify students must complete an application, including parent/guardian signatures. Students in this program can use all part time, weekend and summer work to count towards the necessary hours required. For every 120 hours worked, students will receive credit for one course, up to a total of 4 courses/16 credits.
